Terms and requirements

- Visas are not required for citizens of 38 countries for stays up to 3 months. Double check current visa and passport requirements before coming to the USA, and if applicable apply for a visa to Hawaii your self in your home country. The process can take several weeks, so apply early. Make sure your passport will be valid for at least 6 months after exiting Hawaii.
- You should know the name of your resort or hotel and be able to show a return air ticket out of the country if asked for by immigration officials.
- Wherever you choose to go on the islands, remember to mind your manners and watch your step. Hawaii has strict laws about trespassing on both private land and government land not intended for public use. Trespassing is always illegal.
- Do not drink in public places. Possession of narcotics is illegal, you will face immediate deportation for carrying drugs around with you.
- Foreigners are subject to the laws of the country in which they are travelling and will receive no special consideration because they are tourists. If you find yourself in a sticky legal predicament, contact your embassy.
- Never leave your valuables unattended. Travelflex will not be responsible for any loss or theft. Never leave your bags unattended, due to security concerns about terrorism.
- Public nudity (as at beaches) is illegal in Hawaii.
- A travel insurance policy to cover theft, loss and medical problems is a good idea. Travelflex does not include such insurance, you are responsible for having a valid travel insurance.
